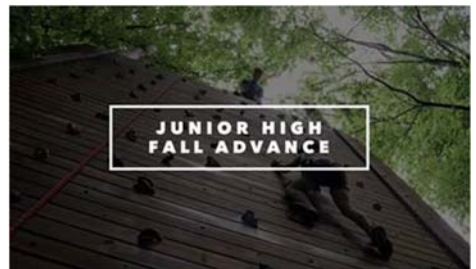

We will begin our 13th year of KidZone the week of October 7th at 3:00 p.m. Herb Ross and Pastor Bill Heaton have met with Mr. Tom Hager, Principal of Malabar Intermediate School. He is excited and grateful we are coming back. He has lined up school busing to take our students home each night. That is a huge help for us and our students' families. Here is what we need:

- 15 students each day, Monday to Thursday from 2:30 to 4:30 p.m.
- 15 Tutors each day from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m., 60 total for each week. This is a huge need. Just think, a public school is asking us to come!
- We are asking for ONE HOUR, ONE DAY a week.

Suppose you see a brother or sister who has no food or clothing, and you say, “Good-bye and have a good day; stay warm and eat well!”—but then you don’t give that person any food or clothing. What good does that do? So you see, faith by itself isn’t enough. Unless it produces good deeds, it is dead and useless.”*
