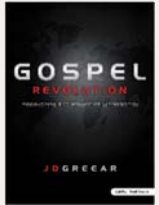

# Satan Tutorial

Does Satan exist?

Jesus, Paul, & John believed and taught about him. **YES**  
John 17:15; 2 Corinthians 11:14-15; 1 John 5:18-20

What are his names?

The evil one: John 17:15

Satan—adversary: Job 1:6

Devil—accuser: Matthew 4:1

Lucifer—morning star: Isaiah 14:12

The serpent: Genesis 3:1, 1 Corinthians 11:3

Beelzebub Luke 11:15

The ruler of the kingdom of the air: Ephesians 2:2

The prince of this world: John 12:31

What is his origin?

Satan is a created spirit being/angel, Genesis 1:31.

He was created with moral judgement and high intelligence but without a physical body. He rebelled against God allowing pride to motivate his desire and effort to be like the Most High. Isaiah 14:12-15, 1 Timothy 3:6

What are his abilities/powers?

Satan is not God! Isaiah 46:9-10 While he is powerful, intelligent, swift and influential — he is limited in every aspect. He does not know everything nor the future;

*(over)*

he can not read your mind; he can only be in one place at a time; he can do only what he is permitted to do.

What is his goal?

To rob God of worship and oppose and destroy every work of God. Matthew 4:1-11

What are his tactics?

Lies, John 8:44; deception, Revelation 12:9; murder, Psalm 106:37

*“They (demons) will also try to use temptation, doubt, guilt, fear, confusion, sickness, envy, pride, slander, or any other means possible to hinder a Christian’s witness and usefulness.”*

Wayne Grudem Systematic Theology, p. 415

What is his destination?

Judgement in eternal hell: Revelation 20:7-9

Do I need protection now?

Paul warns us to not be unaware of his schemes- 2 Corinthians 2:11 & Ephesians 6:11 and Jesus prays for us-John 17:15 & Hebrews 7:25 so **YES**

What should be my response?

Live a courageous, obedient, faith filled life knowing that the Lord is God and he will protect you.  
2 Thessalonians 3:3, 1 John 4:4; 5:18-20
