CHURCH TUTORIAL

FEBRUARY 2, 2020

- Church is the translation of the Greek word “ekklesia” which means called out ones.

115 Times used in the N.T.

85 Times refers to a local gathering

15 Times refers to the church universal

15 Times are uncertain

The significance is the importance the N.T. places on the local church.

- The N.T. uses two primary word pictures to help us understand the church.
 1. Body of Christ - Col. 1:18, Eph. 1:22 & 23
 2. Head - Christ Eph. 5:23 & 24
 3. Members - individual believers
 4. Bride of Christ - 2 Cor. 11:2 & 3, Rev. 19:7-9, 21:2 & 9
- When did the church begin?
 - Baptism of the Holy Spirit places a believer into the Body of Christ. 1Cor. 12:12 & 13, Gal. 3:27
 - The promise of Spirit baptism is future in the Gospels. Matt. 3:11
 - The church and the baptism of the Holy Spirit is still future in the beginning of Acts. Acts 1:4 & 5
 - In Acts 2 the disciples are filled with the Holy Spirit.
 - In Acts 11:15 & 16 Peter realizes that at Pentecost (Acts 2) they were baptized by the Holy Spirit.
 - Therefore, the church began at Pentecost when believers were first baptized by the Holy Spirit, Acts 2
- What are the characteristics of the Universal or Invisible Church?
 - Unity- John 17:20 & 21, Eph. 4:4-6
 - Holiness- 1 Peter 2:9
 - Catholicity (all inclusive - universal)- Rev. 5:9, 7:9
 - Foundation - Jesus Christ- Eph. 2:19 & 20

- What are the Biblical guidelines for the operation of the church?
 - Meet regularly, originally on the first day of the week.
1 Cor. 16:2, Acts 20:7
 - There are to be two officers - Elders and Deacons.
Acts 20:17-38, 1 Tim. 5:17
 - > Qualifications of elders and deacons 1 Tim. 3:1-7,
1 Tim. 3:8-13, Titus 1:5-9
 - Discipline is to be exercised.
 - > Purpose — reconciliation and restoration Gal. 6:1,
2 Cor. 2:6-8
 - > Method— Matt. 18:15-17
 - > Action—withdraw fellowship until repentance
1 Cor. 5:1-5

- What are the ordinances (Biblically required practices)?
 - Lord's Supper/Communion/Lord's Table 1 Cor. 11:20-34
 - Baptism Matt. 28:19-20

- What is the Biblical form of government (polity)?
Elders are to rule, 1 Tim. 3:5 & 5:17 with input from the people,
Acts 6:3-6. It is not a pure democracy nor an authoritarian
dictatorship, Hebrews 13:17, Acts 15:22

- What should the programming look like?
 - > Worship Col. 3:15-17
 - > Fellowship Hebrews 10:24 & 25
 - > Evangelism Mark 16:15
 - > Prayer Acts 2:42
 - > Teaching/discipleship Matt. 28:18-20
 - > Service/equipping/generosity Acts 2:42-47, Eph. 4:12

The Four Tasks of the Church

- 1. Worship** **Praising the Transcendent God**
John 17:24
John 4:23— *“Yet a time is coming and has now come when the true worshipers will worship the Father in the Spirit and in truth, for they are the kind of worshipers the Father seeks.”*

- 2. Word** **Teaching for wisdom and obedience**
John 17:7
James 1:22— *“Do not merely listen to the word, and so deceive yourselves. Do what it says.”*

- 3. Welcome** **Becoming a unified healthy community**
John 17:20 & 22
John 13:35— *“By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.”*

- 4. Witness** **Reaching a lost needy world**
John 17:22
Romans 10:14-15— *“How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: ‘How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!’”*
